Procedures if there are Covid cases in a class

The procedures that schools are to follow if there are Covid cases in a class have changed from what they were last term – please see details below:

One case in a class: parents and carers will receive a message informing of a positive case in the class and to keep an eye for their child displaying any symptoms. This message will be for information only.

Two or more cases in a class: parents and carers will receive a second message informing of two or more cases in the class. Parents and carers will be asked to do a LFT on their child every morning before coming to school for seven days. If the test is positive on any of the days, the child should self isolate in line with the Welsh Government's guidelines. This is not relevant for pupils under the age of 5.

If your child is displaying any symptoms, including ones other than the three main symptoms, **please don't send him / her to school and arrange a PCR test.** If your child is under 5, he / she should not attend school until the symptoms have cleared.

If a pupil tests positive and that he/ she has a brother or sister in school, the brother / sister should take a LFT every morning – as long as the daily LFT is negative, they can continue to attend school as usual.
