A warm welcome to those new to Ysgol Plas Coch. I am fast approaching the end of my first year as Chair of the PTA, with the AGM set for Thursday 16th October at 6pm in the school. I am looking forward to finding out how much money we have raised over the last 12 months by the wonderful team of volunteers with the support of all parents and teaching staff. Our current treasurer, Kate Wynne, has been busy preparing our accounts and filing our returns to ensure that we comply with legal requirements. A huge thanks to Kate, who does a lot of work behind the scenes, such as preparing floats for events, exploring new fundraising opportunities and stock controls our supplies. She always volunteers for events too. She is a real asset to our team.



We had our first PTA meeting of this academic year recently, where we were updated on various projects. The PTA funded transport for school trips last year, at a cost of £2500. There were also smaller projects such as melon slices given to every pupil on sports days (which were very well received), a donation of £100 to Year 6 events and £320 for the bus taking the choir to Llangollen Eisteddfod. You may also have noticed that the wooden structure in the school yard has been re-opened. The repair work was arranged and part-funded by the PTA. Thanks to Frances Perrin for co-ordinating this. The work was carried out during the summer holidays by JEConstruction, with generous donations from Wrexham Travis Perkins and Tyre Trend. This is part of a bigger project to continually maintain and improve the outdoor space. We are applying for external funding to help with this bigger project. At the meeting we also considered what events would like to arrange this academic year. We are now looking to recruit enough volunteers to plan and deliver our ambitious plans. It is very much a case of many hands make light work. We can only do what we can do and every volunteer is in control of how much time they give. Please keep an eye on the noticeboard and Year WhatsApp groups for requests to help and get in touch to volunteer. This year, we are looking to purchase a new piano, repair and improve the PTA shed and continue with the improvements to the outdoor space.

As I mentioned, the AGM will be held in October. The rules of our constitution state that all committee roles are to be voted on.

This means that, although I am willing to continue as Chair, I have no automatic right.

There are a number of non-committee roles that we are looking for volunteer to fill.

We are hoping to organise a Spring Fair and so need a team to begin the preparations. We also want to continue to improve our communication with parents, so are looking for people to manage the noticeboard and more people to post messages on the year WhatsApp groups. Ideally, We would like year reps. More volunteers means smaller tasks and bigger achievements.

I look forward to meeting more parents at the AGM on 16 th October (6pm at school). Come along to find out how the PTA works. The only expectation in attending is that you eat some of the biscuits.

Finally, thank you to those who are signed up and using Easyfundraising (easyfundraising.org.uk). There are currently 41 supporters who together have

raised £167 just by shopping online (and can now be used instore). The

current leader has raised an amazing £41. I am trying to catch you up, but I am some way

off. Also, thanks to those who have signed up to the Parents Lottery (theparentslottery.org). There are 42 supporters raising £232 so far.

I hope you have found your free Stikins name labels useful. More money can be raised for school by using our fundraising code 15909 when purchasing more (stikins.co.uk).

Remember, the AGM is on October 16 th , followed by a PTA meeting. It would be great to see some new faces. We are a friendly bunch. Did I mention that there will be biscuits?
