Dear parents/guardians

We are pleased to let you know that there will be an opportunity for Year 6 pupils to visit Cardiff for 3 days from Wednesday to Friday, June 3rd – 5th 2026.

We will be arranging the visit in conjunction with the Urdd Gwersyll in Cardiff and the cost of the visit will be approximately **£205.00**. We don't expect there to be a change in the cost one way or the other but it does depend on some of the activities that are yet to be confirmed. There's no need to be a member of the Urdd to attend.

The price includes transport, food, accommodation and activities (to be confirmed) such as ten-pin bowling, Cardiff City Football Stadium tour, trip on a boat in the Bay, Techniquest, and Royal Mint. They will also possibly have the opportunity to visit attractions such as Big Pit, St Fagan's museum and the National museum. During the three days, the children will be staying in the Urdd Centre which is part of the Millennium Centre (<https://www.urdd.cymru/en/residential-centres/cardiff>). Staff from the school will accompany the children with the number of staff depending on how many children go.

If you'd like your child to go, please complete the pro-forma below and return it to school and pay a **deposit of £35.00 via ParentPay by 13.2.26**. You will be able to pay in instalments after this if you prefer as the trip will be live on ParentPay from 30.1.26. All payments are to be made by 15.5.26 please.

It is possible that you qualify for remission for the cost of the accommodation and food which is £138.00 (not the bus and activities), if you receive one of the following:-

- Universal Credit - if you are working you must be earning less than £7,400 per year (£616.67 per month)
- Income Support
- Job seeker's allowance (income-based)
- Immigration and Asylum-seeker's allowance
- Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit - providing you're not entitled to Working Tax Credit with an annual total income below the HMRC set limit

If you think that you are eligible for one of the above please let the school know and provide a copy (a photocopy can be made in school) of a document that proves this as evidence for us to send to the authority, as well as your date of birth and National Insurance Number.
